Additional late night/early morning Thruway motorcoach service serving Pacific Surfliner® route cities. Travel on these buses is reserved and must be part of an itinerary involving a train trip. Advance purchase is required since most stations are unstaffed at the hours the buses operate. Reserved, ticketed customers have priority seating. Passengers traveling north of Los Angeles with valid reservation numbers will be carried; unreserved, ticketed passengers are carried on a space-available basis. Tickets available at Los Angeles, San Diego, Solana Beach and Oceanside 30 minutes before the departure of the buses marked with an asterisk (*) below.
